Group	Tees	Advancing Score
1 Holers	150 yards	7 (twice)
4 Holers	150 yards	30 (twice)
4 Holers+	Junior Tees	30 (twice)
6 Holers	Junior Tees	40 (twice)
9 Holers	Junior Tees	50 (twice)

Groups will be divided by age and ability levels. Instruction sessions will last approximately 45 minutes and then groups will be chaperoned, by the parents, to the golf course. Chaperones are not required for the 9 & 18 hole groups.
